CLINICAL SERVICES

(1) Haemodialysis (in-center)

The Kowloon City Dialysis Centre was set up in 1981 with a donation by Dr. Li Ka Shing. It was the first charitable centre in Hong Kong to provide subsidised haemodialysis treatment. The centre was in operation till 2017.

Currently, the haemodialysis service is provided at The Jockey Club Dialysis Centre at WoChe. The centre was set up in 1994 with a donation from the Jockey Club Charities Trust.

Up to 78 patients receive 5-6 hours

treatment twice or thrice a week at the centre. The treatment is subsidised by HKKF at around \$1100 per treatment.





(2) Nocturnal Home Haemodialysis

The program was set up in 2007 to support patient to perform the dialysis treatment at home, overnight on the alternative night of the week. NHD has a good outcome, allowing full rehabilitation of the patient, including able to work during the day time. HKKF supports 60 patients with a subsidy of \$3000/month.



(3) Automated Peritoneal Dialysis (APD)

The program was launched in 1997 to allow a patient to perform the dialysis treatment at home overnight while asleep.

APD has the benefit of freeing the patient from treatment during the day time, allowing full rehabilitation, including enable a patient to return to work

So far, HKKF has procured 727 APD machines for free loaning to patients (equivalent of HK\$61 million of donation of fund/ machine).

The program has supported 1715 patients. Currently, HKKF has 558 APD machines for free loaning to patients.



(4) Drug subsidised program

Since 2002, with support from various pharmaceutical companies, HKKF has supported patients to receive the newer (high costing) drugs by providing a 50% subsidy of the drug cost.

The program has included anti-rejection drugs for kidney transplant and erythropoietin for renal anaemia.

PROFESSIONAL TRAINING EDUCATION PROGRAM

In conjunction with Hong Kong Society of Nephrology and other organisations, HKKF sponsors renal conferences, seminars, training programs in nephrology, and renal nursing courses.

HKKF awards Fellowships and Scholarships to medical and nursing staff for overseas training and attending conference in renal medicine.

An annual research grant is awarded to the top research program in nephrology (in conjunction with Hong Kong Society of Nephrology













PROMOTION KIDNEY HEALTH ORGAN DONATION

WORLD KIDNEY DAY

HKKF together with Hong Kong Society of Nephrology, Hospital Authority, Department of Health and other society/organisation join the Annual World Kidney Day, mounting public campaign to promote kidney health and providing health screening for the public



ORGAN DONATION

HKKF is the convenor of the Hong Kong Organ Donation Action Group since 2016, to promote organ donation with public campaign and to support organ donation promotion programs.



On 1 July 2017, in conjunction with The Board of The Management of The Chinese Permanent Cemeteries, a memorial site was set up at the Memorial Garden at Tseung Kwan O Chinese Permanent Cemetery to honor the deceased organ donors with a memorial plaque.



FUNDRAISING

HKKF is a charitable organsiation. The funding for the subsidised programs, education and promotion program is from donation from the general public, organisations and philanthropies, fund raising activities, charity dinners, concert, tea sales and flag day
